Medway Public Library Card Application Form

Any individual who lives, works, attends school, or owns property in Massachusetts may apply for and receive a library card upon verification of proper identification and proof of present home address. Children must be at least 5 years old to receive a library card. Children under age 16 must have this form signed by a parent or legal guardian to receive a library card.

 - 1. Passport, Alien Resident Card, or University or school photo ID
 - 2. Government issued photo ID cards, such as Military ID
 - 3. State issued photo ID, such as welfare, Medicaid or FID card

- Proof of current local address:
 - 1. Utility or tax bill (dated within the past 60 days)
 - 2. Imprinted bank check or deposit slip
 - 3. Official school schedule with applicant's name and address typed on it
 - 4. Official letter verifying residency from social services provider, temporary employer, or short-term residence (dated within past 30 days)
 - 5. Postcard mailed to applicant from the Library
